FREE SCHOOL MEALS AND MILK FOR CHILDREN IN YEARS RECEPTION—6

Your child could get a free school meal/milk if you receive any of the following. By applying the school receive additional money even if you do not wish your child to have dinners/milk.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and you don't get more than £16,190 a year)
 - Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit (with annual earned income of no more than £7,400 after tax and not including any benefits you get).

Apply today if you receive any of these benefits. It takes 5 mins and in most cases you will be told if you qualify.
