PACKED LUNCHES

Please ensure that your child's packed lunch is healthy:-

Contents of a packed lunch could include:-

- Sandwich/wrap/rice cakes;
- Piece of salad (cucumber, tomatoes, peppers, celery);
 - Snack of cheese, sausage, crisps;
 - Sweet treat (if child likes) of biscuit, yogurt;
 - Drink (water, fruit juice, smoothie);

Please do not include sweets (such as haribos) or chocolate bars (such as milky ways, etc) as children will be asked not to eat them and take them home. Please remember we are a nut-free school.

Please do not give your child more food than they can reasonably eat. Please ensure the containers your child's food is in are easy to open for them. The lunchtime staff will ask the children to take all packed lunch rubbish home with them so you can see what they have eaten.
