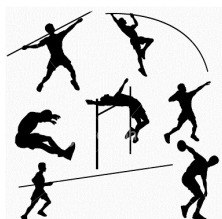

Just a reminder that Sports Day for KS1 will take place on Tuesday 14th July, followed by a picnic.

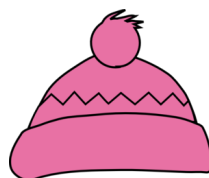
