RED WRIST BANDS

When a child has experienced a bumped head or very minor injury, slips are sent home to let you know. We understand that sometimes these slips get mislaid and have introduced a new system to make sure families are aware a minor incident has happened. Along with the existing note children will have a red band placed on their wrist. These are like the wristbands you would be given at a theme park and cannot be removed unless cut with scissors. If your child comes home with a red band on but does not have the accompanying note, please do speak to the teacher or teaching assistant in that class so they can let you know what has happened.
